




## TYPES OF WHEELGHAIRS

A manual or push wheelchair is used when a person can use their hands and arms. Some people use them when they have an injury such as a broken leg.


A sports wheelchair sits low to the ground and moves fast. It is used to play basketball, tennis, racing and other sports.



A motorized wheelchair can be operated with a joystick control instead of pushing the wheels to make it go and stop.

lan told Kit about when he first started to play basketball when he was young. He had wanted to play with the other kids but was afraid to ask to join in the game.




All that changed one day when the basketball bounced over to lan.

With the help of a personal care assistant, wheelchair, van and a service dog, I can do all of the things the other kids do!






Modifications to my van help me to go to activities, school, work and visit friends.

A wheelchair van is a vehicle with a motorized lift that goes up and down and lets a wheelchair user get in and out and ride anywhere they want to go.




SERVICE ANIMAL

# SOUP-ER Kitchen




Whether typing in an office or volunteering for those in need, working not only feels good for the worker, but also gives something good back to the world.




"There are many different types of disabilities," lan said, "from people are born with to ones that don't last too long to ones you can't even see."


